Bugasch & Assoc is an accounting firm at 1701 E Lake Ave (Waukegan



Rd) with a reception area and 3 offices and will be a 2 artist venue. Their high traffic time of year is during tax season so exhibits will be held for 6 mos Jan-June only. If you are interested in either location simply add a note to your application or send us an email. Gallery managers will meet in early Dec to assign artists to specific venues, so you should receive your placements before the end of Dec.

Rotating exhibits? We are considering having a moving exhibit of some of the demo artists work that could be set up for companies for a short period of time, perhaps 1 month. If you're interested in helping transform local business space with beautiful art, let us know.
